Scope of service	SilverDAT Repair Cost Tracker

Short description	The SilverDAT Repair Cost Tracker offers users, such as insurance companies and OEMs, the possibility to perform statistical evaluations and analyses with a focus on repair data. The aim is to create a valid, data-based foundation for deriving recommendations for action and strategic decisions. The following basic statistical evaluations can be performed using the SilverDAT Repair Cost Tracker:	
	1. Overview view:	
	Overview of the main market changes and presentation of the average cost of a vehicle parts group averaged over all vehicle parts groups for the current and previous year at monthly level.	
	2. Parts Costs view:	
	Presentation of costs of specific vehicle parts groups and their frequency distribution.	
	3. Claim Costs view:	
	Presentation of the evolution of the total costs of an average claim and its cost components.	
	4. Part Cost Development view:	
	Presentation of the cost evolution of specific vehicle parts groups.	
	5. Billing Rates view:	
	Presentation of the evolution of hourly rates.
